

ORDINANCE NO. 100


AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE UNAUTHORIZED POSSESSION OF A FIREARM ON THE GROUNDS OF OR WITHIN BUILDINGS OWNED OR LEASED BY THE CITY OF LINN VALLEY, KANSAS.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LINN VALLEY, KANSAS:

1. It is unlawful to possess a firearm on the grounds of or within the following buildings owned or leased by the city of Linn Valley, Kansas:
 - A. 22412 2400 Road, known as City Hall;
 - B. Any other City owned or leased building if said building is conspicuously marked with signs stating that firearms are prohibited in such building.
2. This ordinance shall not apply to:
 - A. Duly authorized law enforcement officers, fire personnel authorized to carry firearms pursuant to K.S.A. 31-157 and amendments thereto, or military personnel when engaged in their duties to the extent permitted by federal or state law;
 - B. Public officers or public employees trained and duly licensed in firearm safety while on City grounds for the purpose of performing periodic and authorized deer harvests;
 - C. Attorneys when the firearm is possessed solely for the purpose of attempting to submit the firearm into evidence or examining the firearm in the course of a pending court proceeding.
3. For the purposes of this section, a firearm is any weapon designed or having the capacity to propel a projectile by force of an explosion or combustion that is calculated to ~~be~~ reasonably likely to produce death or serious bodily injury.
4. Any person who enters the grounds of or a building listed herein with a firearm in violation of this section shall be required to forfeit the firearm, either temporarily or permanently, and may be required to leave the premises regardless of the public nature of the grounds or building.
5. Violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of up to \$1000 per violation and/or up to six months in jail.


6. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication in the official newspaper of the City of Linn Valley, Kansas.
