

ORDINANCE NO. 3

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LINN VALLEY, KANSAS PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF CITY OFFICERS; DUTIES AND COMPENSATION; REMOVAL AND QUALIFICATIONS OF SAID OFFICERS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LINN VALLEY, KANSAS:


SECTION ONE: Appointment of City Officers; Duties and Compensation. The Mayor, with the consent of the Governing Body, may appoint, at the first regular meeting of the Governing Body in the month following an election, the following city officers, to-wit: a city attorney, a judge of the municipal court, a clerk, a treasurer, a city marshal-chief of police, policemen, facilities and road supervisor, building officer and such other officers as deemed necessary; and may retain a licensed professional engineer to act in the capacity of city engineer and, also, a licensed Kansas attorney to act in the capacity of legal advisor, for specifically defined duties. The duties and pay of the various officers provided for shall be regulated by ordinance.

SECTION TWO: Removal. A majority of all the members of the Governing Body may remove any such officers; or, for good cause, the Mayor may remove any such officer with the consent of the Governing Body.


SECTION THREE: Qualification of Officer; How Vacancies Filled. The officers elected or appointed under this act shall be qualified electors of said city, except the city may appoint non-residents as city attorney, municipal judge and as law enforcement officers when deemed necessary including the appointment of nonresidents as city attorney, municipal judge and as law enforcement officers when deemed necessary including the appointment of nonresidents who also serve as city attorney, municipal judgment or law enforcement officers of another municipality or public agency; PROVIDED, that nothing herein shall authorize the appointment of nonresidents of this state. The city attorney shall be a qualified elector of the county in which said city is located or of an adjoining county. The removal from such city of any officer elected or appointed under this act, who is required to be a qualified elector thereof, shall occasion a vacancy in such office. All vacancies in office, except the offices of mayor and councilmen, may be filled until the next regular time for appointment by appointment of the Governing body. Every appointment to office, and the date thereof, shall be entered on the journal of proceedings of the Governing Body.

SECTION FOUR: Take Effect. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
