



## **Information on Hold & Haul Sewer Tank Maintenance**

A properly maintained sewer tank should be able to handle wastewater from the kitchen, bathroom, laundry, etc. Some items can cause blockages and backups, and may create unsafe conditions. Never pour the following items down drains or flush down toilets.

- Grease and oils (byproducts of cooking that comes from meat fats, oils, shortening, butter, margarine, and food scraps)
- Wipes of any kind, i.e. cleaning wipes and baby wipes even if these are labeled “flushable”
- Feminine products
- Explosive or flammable material
- Kitty litter or aquarium gravel
- Strong chemicals or toxic, caustic, poisonous substance or degreasing solvents
- Diapers or cloth of any kind
- Fuel or lubricating oil, paint thinner, antifreeze or any petroleum products
- Plastic objects, seafood shells, or cotton swabs
- Paper plates and cups, wood, ashes, glass
- Glass and Metal
- Sand
