

RESOLUTION NO. 60

A RESOLUTION OUTLINING CERTAIN REGULATIONS THAT THE CITY COUNCIL INTENDS TO IMPLEMENT TO GOVERN THE OPERATION OF THE CITY'S SEWER SYSTEM.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LINN VALLEY, KANSAS:

- Section 1. Sewer connection shall be required for all residences within the Sewer Service Ares. Residences not connected may not be occupied.
- Section 2. Camping Lots without a permanent structure that have an approved and functioning holding tank as of the date of this Resolution, and which are served by the City's Hold and Haul service shall be exempt from the requirements of Section 1 unless the holding tank ceases to function properly or needs to be replaced, or the owners cease to avail themselves of the Hold and Haul Service, in which case the holding tank must be decommissioned in a manner consistent with City requirements and no replacement may be installed.
- Section 3. After the date this Resolution is approved, no new holding tanks may be installed anywhere within the Sewer Service Area.
- Section 4. If a permanent residence is constructed on any Camping Lot as described in Section 2, the holding tank must be decommissioned in a manner consistent with City requirements and a sewer connection made to the residence at the landowners expense, is required before the property may be occupied.
- Section 5. Unpaid fees incurred by owners of properties connected to the Sewer or served by the Hold and Haul System shall become a lien against the property to the extent and through the process allowed by Kansas statute.
- Section 6. This Resolution is intended to express the intent of the Council that the regulations described herein shall be incorporated into the Sewer Operating Ordinance governing the City's sewer system.
